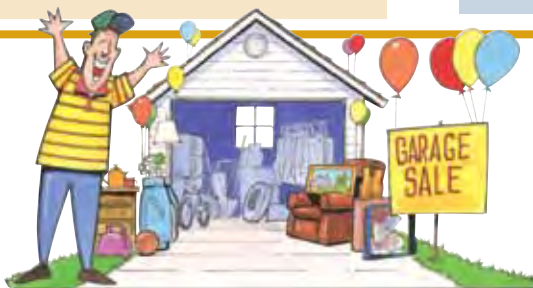

Now that school is back in session, Meadow Pointe CDD asks for the cooperation of parents dropping off their students at Sand Pine by using the drop off point within the school property rather than parking their vehicles on the right of way by the entrances to the property. The CDD is spending approximately \$185,000 this fiscal year on landscape maintenance.

Additionally, CDD personnel spend many man hours picking up trash and filling in ruts on the side of the roads. These efforts and

expenditures enhance the beauty of our community. When cars park on the right of way the grass is killed and many times there are deep ruts left behind. There are no parking signs that were erected by Pasco County.
