Please Drive Safely

Meadow Pointe II would like to remind all of our residents to please drive safely, especially within our neighborhood. Our community is very active; there are almost always bicyclists, pedestrians, and children along our streets, sidewalks, driveways, and yards. Please don't speed in MPII, use your turn signals, put the phone away, and stay alert.

It is October, and schools have been back for a while now. Hopefully everyone has adjusted their schedules to account for bus routes, school traffic, etc. But it is still important to be very cautious anywhere near the times school is starting or letting

out. Also – parents – remember that the speed limit on school property is 5 mph at ALL times. It is crucial that no one speed within the school parking lots.
